



Goldbelt Frontier employees continue to provide critical technical support to the OTSG G-33 Current Operations Religious Accommodations (RA) Task Force. Mr. Dennis Kellen and Ms. Aisha Harper were temporarily reassigned to provide needed screening and "paralegal" support to process all Army COVID religious exemptions. The Task Force consists of a multidisciplinary staff of clinical, public health, staff judge advocates, operations and medical assistance. We work in close coordi-

nation with various Staff
Action Control Offices
(SACOs) from the Army
Commands (ACOMs), Army Service Component
Commands (ASCCs) and
Direct-Reporting Units
(DRUs) for processing all
RA exemptions before the
15 DEC 2021 deadline.
The complete beginning -to-

end process continues to be refined to ensure maximum efficiency and completeness. Training was provided to ensure proficiency of the Care Point tool for internal staffing and Task Management Tool (TMT) / **Enterprise Task Management** Software Solution (ETMS2). Additionally, an Appeal process has been developed with close coordination from Assistant Secretary of the Army for Manpower & Reserve Affairs ASA (M&RA). Currently, every Soldier who has not received the COVID-19 vaccination will submit a detailed packet through their chain of command to Office of The Surgeon General

(OTSG) for review and approval based on their religious preference. Army is estimating approximately 5,000 packets requiring review for Active Duty Soldiers followed by Reserve and National Guard Soldiers with a 15 JUN 2022 deadline.
